# The Master's Puppeteers

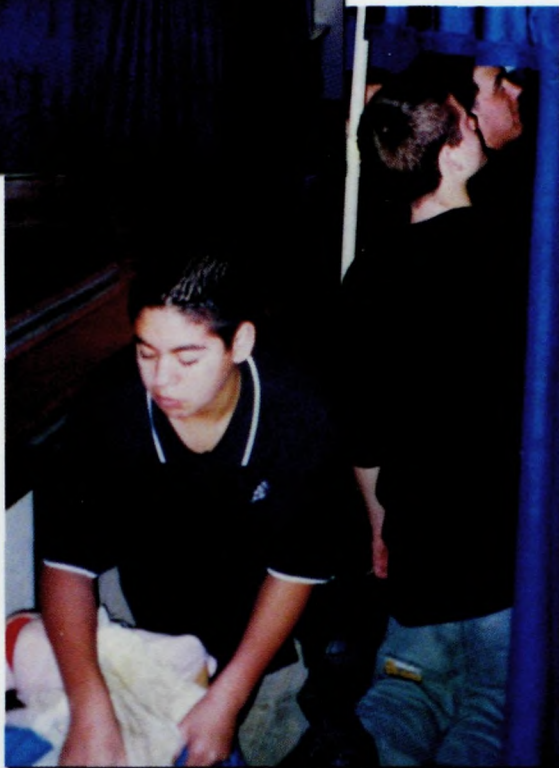
