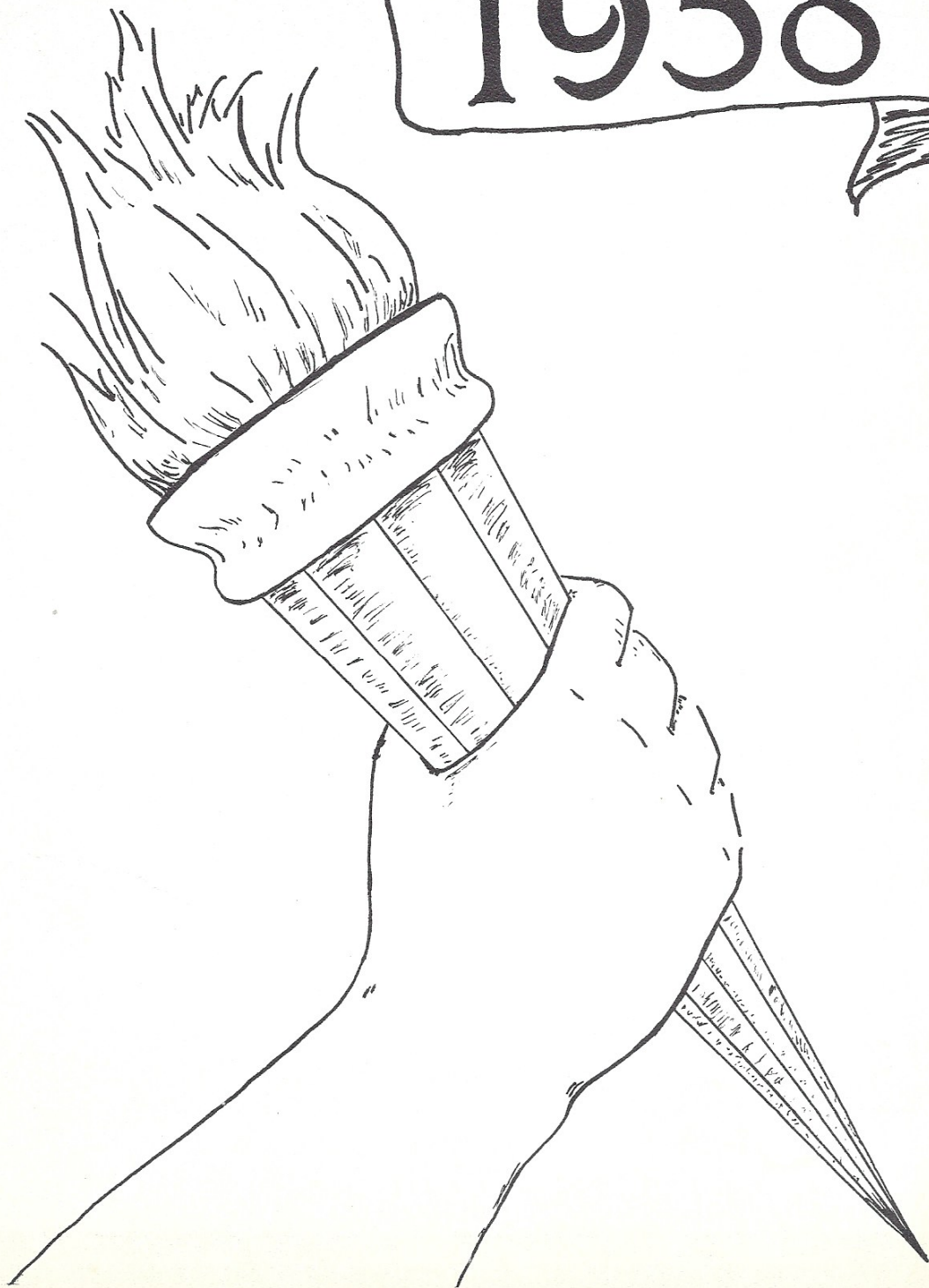

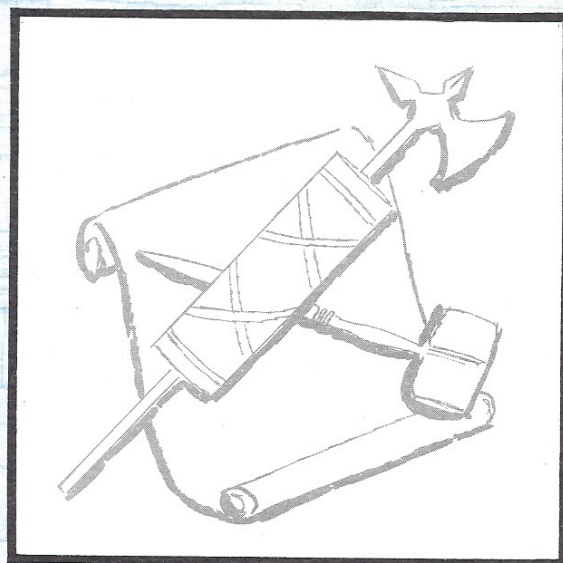
As a Christian, she has inspired us to high ideals. Her wise and kind counsel has done much to mould our characters. Her quiet dignity has won our deepest respect.
